**Enroll your patient in EFMP (complete DD 2792 and patient returns to EFMP office) if:**

1. Chronic Medical Conditions requiring follow-up support or specialty care requiring a visit more than once a year (Patients should be enrolled in EFMP care beyond the level of family practice is needed more than once a year)
2. Mental Health Conditions which meet any of the below conditions:
  - Current and chronic (greater than 6 months) mental health conditions
  - A history or inpatient or intensive outpatient mental health services within the last 5 years
  - Mental Health conditions which require greater than one visit monthly for the last 6 months. This includes medical care from any provider (including primary care).
3. Asthma which meets any of the below conditions:
  - Scheduled use of inhaled and anti-inflammatory agents and/or bronchodilators
  - History of emergency room use or clinic visits for acute asthma exacerbations within the last year
  - History of hospitalization for asthma within the past 5 years
4. A diagnosis of ADHD which meets any of the below conditions:
  - A co-morbid psychological diagnosis
  - requires multiple medications, psycho-pharmaceuticals (other than stimulants) or does not respond to normal doses of medication
  - Requires management and treatment by a mental health provider (psychiatrist, psychologist or other)
  - Requires Individualized Educational Plan or use of behavioral management staff

ADHD which can be managed solely by a Primary Care Provider does NOT need to be enrolled for Army or Air Force dependents, but ALL Navy dependents with ADHD must be enrolled.

5. Requires adaptive equipment or assistive technology (wheelchair, hearing aids, home oxygen therapy, communication devices)
6. Requires Environmental or Architectural considerations (limited steps, wheelchair accessibility, air conditioning)
7. Special conditions: -All Cancer patient must be enrolled for at least 5 years after remission  
-All patients with autism or autism spectrum disorders must be enrolled

**To dis-enroll from EFMP please complete DD 2792 and list all diagnosis with explanation of why they are no longer active (contact EFMP office for current enrollment)**

**Service Specific Overseas Screening**

**Navy Screening**

- Complete DD 2807-1 and NAVMED 1300/1 for each dependent
- Mark N/A if question applies only to Active Duty
- Write "Defer to gaining command" if patient has special needs at query for local capabilities
- Complete DD 2792 if the patient meets enrollment criteria

**Army Screening**

- DA 5888 and DA 7246 completed by the EFMP Office only
- If they meet enrollment criteria, complete a DD 2792
- If they do not need EFMP enrollment, complete a routine physical in AHLTA (EFMP office will review AHLTA). DD 2792 is not needed.
- Return DD 2792 to patient

**Air Force Screening**

- AF 4380 and AF 1466 by the Air Force EFMP office only
- complete a DD 2792 for all family members, regardless of if they meet enrollment criteria
- If patient does NOT have special needs, complete DD 2792 with diagnosis of Well Child/Adult and frequency of Care FP annually
- Return DD 2792 to patient
