### Provider Instructions for Army Overseas Screening

Dear Medical Provider

Your patient has made an appointment with you for a Department of the Army Overseas Screening. **This screening is necessary for the Army to ensure that appropriate medical care is available for family members when they are stationed outside the United States.**

Please review the attached criteria for enrollment in the Exceptional Family Member Program (EFMP)

1. If your patient does NOT meet any of the criteria for enrollment in EFMP, please complete a history and physical with needed routine health care maintenance. It is helpful if you mention in the note that the patient's medical needs can be handled by a family practice physician and EFMP enrollment is not warranted. If you are a provider at a military treatment facility it is sufficient to complete the note in AHLTA (hard copy to the patient is NOT needed). If you are a provider at a civilian medical facility, please provide the patient with a hard copy of the encounter.
2. If the patient meets any of the medical criteria for enrollment in EFMP, please complete the attached DD 2792 and return to the patient. A PDF fillable version of the DD 2792 (Aug 2014) can be found at <http://www.wrnmmc.capmed.mil> →healthcare services→Readiness→EFMP.
3. Please do not complete the DA 5888 or DA 7246. These documents will be completed by the EFMP office.
