

# Parking at Walter Reed Bethesda

*Valid Parking Placards must be entirely visible with the tag number facing forward.*

## PATIENT PARKING

Staff may park in Patient Parking Garages if they have an appointment or are accompanying a family member to an appointment, but only for the duration of the appointment. Staff should remove their parking placard prior to entering the patient garage in order to park.

- America Garage (63) and Arrowhead Garage (55) are designated Patient Parking garages.
- Evening/night staff members may park in Bldg 55 during their shift, but must move their vehicle by 0800 Monday – Friday.

## HANDICAP PARKING

Disabled staff must display their state issued handicap permit inside their vehicle and/or have a disabled parking designation on their current license plate.

- Authorized to park in any handicap space, except America Garage (*unless they are being seen as a patient*).
- Staff with handicap placards and license plate shall not park in a non-handicap space unless staff member also has a red or carpool parking placard.
- Handicap parking is a first come, first serve.

## RED PLACARD HOLDERS

Authorized to park in BLDG 54, BLDG 32 (MUPS), BLDG 68 (Sanctuary Hall), BLDG 57 (H Garage) and Stone Lake Rd.

- Staff must visit BLDG 102 with proof of insurance, car registration, and driver's license to have their CAC programmed for garage access. BLDG 102 Hours of Operation are 0530–1530.
- Placard issue and turn in is done by Directorate Parking Champions.
- Only current placard designs are authorized.

## CARPOOL PLACARD HOLDERS

Authorized to park in BLDG 55, 4th and 5th decks.

- Carpool is reserved for staff members possessing a valid carpool permit.
- Carpool enrollment is managed by NSAB Transportation and will be open in the near future.
- Red placard holders are not authorized to park in Carpool spaces.

## MOTORCYCLE PARKING

Authorized to park in BLDG 54 and BLDG 63.

- No placard required
- Vehicle must be registered with NSAB at BLDG 102

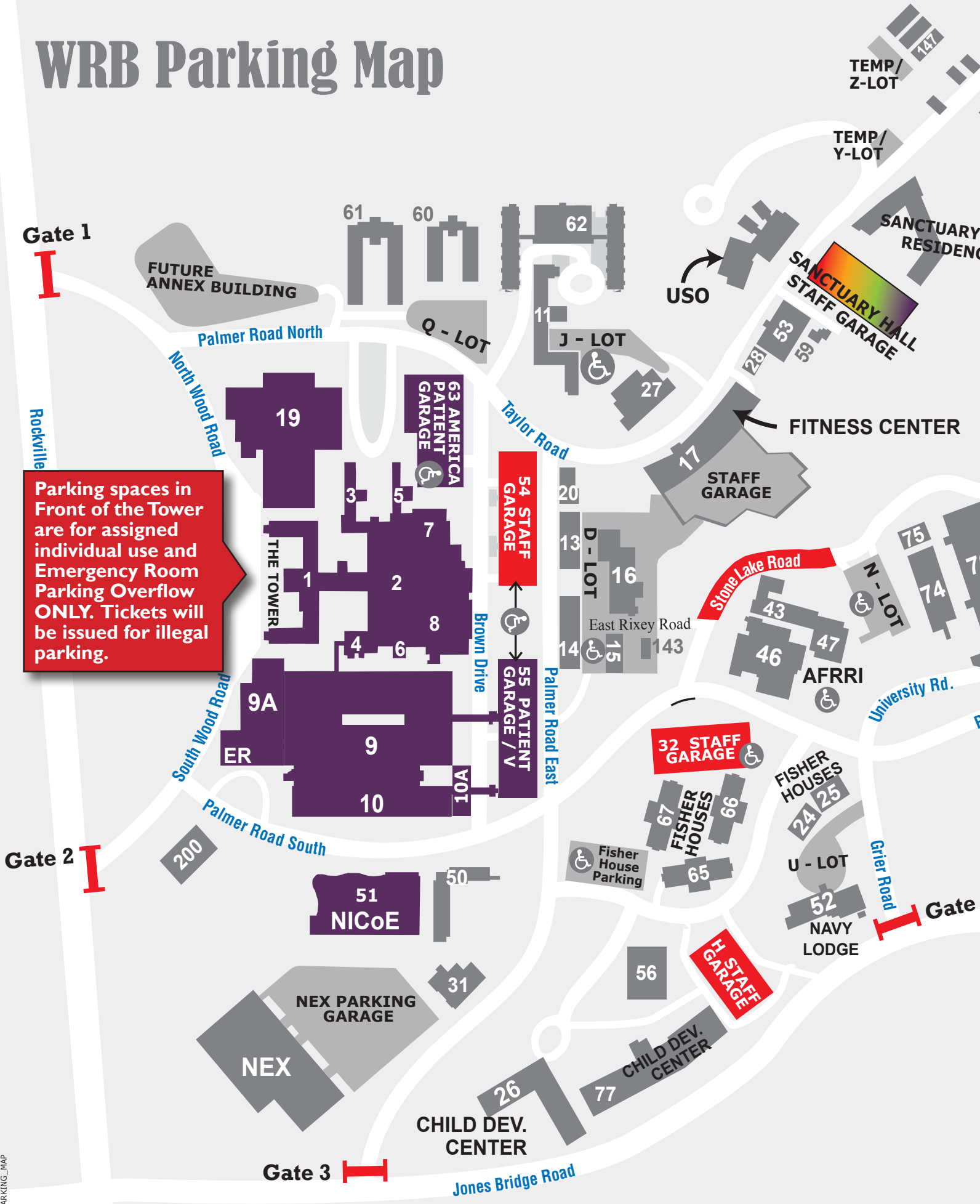
## MASS TRANSPORTATION BENEFIT PROGRAM
