<b>General Dentistry Clinical Update</b> <i>*Eligibility:</i> Military and Federal agency dentists only. This course is directed at, but not limited to, mid-grade to senior dental officers.	5	50	26-30 October 2015
<b>Orofacial Pain</b> <i>*Eligibility:</i> Military and Federal agency dentists only. Course participants are encouraged to review head and neck anatomy before attending this course.	5	30	2-6 November 2015
<b>Endodontics</b> <i>*Eligibility:</i> Military and Federal agency dentists only	5	32	7-11 December 2015
<b>Pain Control &amp; Nitrous Oxide Anxiolysis</b> <i>*Eligibility:</i> Active duty military only. Other Federal agency dentists will be accepted on a space-available basis.	4	30	14-17 December 2015 Mon thru Thurs
<b>Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery Review (Oral Surgeons)</b> <i>*Eligibility:</i> Active duty Military Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons who are board-eligible and plan to take the Part II examination (Orals) of the American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery in 2015. <b>Oral &amp; Maxillofacial Pathology</b> <i>*Eligibility:</i> Military and Federal agency dentists only	5	50+	25-29 January 2016
<b>Pediatric Dentistry &amp; Orthodontics</b> <i>*Eligibility:</i> Active duty Federal agency dentists only. Please note: This course is particularly advantageous for the general dentist who is receiving overseas orders. The timing of the course makes it convenient to take it prior to detaching from a CONUS duty station.	5	35	22-26 February 2016
<b>Oral Medicine, Oral Radiology &amp; Pharmacology</b> <i>*Eligibility:</i> Military and Federal agency dentists only	5	50	29 Feb-4 March 2016
<b>Oral &amp; Maxillofacial Surgery</b> <i>*Eligibility:</i> Military and Federal agency dentists only	5	36	14-18 March 2016
<b>Digital Dentistry for Orthodontic, Oral Surgery, and Implant Applications</b> <i>*Eligibility:</i> Active Duty Military only – Orthodontists, Oral Surgeons, and Periodontists have priority.	3	20	22-24 March 2016 Tues thru Thurs
<b>Prosthodontics</b> <i>*Eligibility:</i> Military and Federal agency dentists only	5	40	11-15 April 2016
<b>Periodontics</b> <i>*Eligibility:</i> Military and Federal agency dentists only	5	36	18-22 April 2016
<b>Basic Osseointegration &amp; Dental Implant Treatment</b> <i>*Eligibility:</i> Active duty military general dentists (Junior officers) with little or no training in the restoration of dental implants.	5	20	25-29 April 2016
<b>General Dentistry Treatment Planning</b> <i>*Eligibility:</i> Military and Federal agency dentists only	5	30	2-6 May 2016
<b>Advanced Operative Dentistry</b> <i>*Eligibility:</i> Active duty military only. Due to a high demand for this course, individuals that attended the May 2014 course will not be eligible for enrollment this year.	5	50	16-20 May 2016
